The 'Resolution & Adventure' Medal struck in 1772 in pure copper is an exciting item. It is likely that this was a trial strike undertaken before the silver medals were produced. It is the first we have seen, and it is exceedingly rare if not unique. There is also a La Perouse Medal in bronze with a suspension loop attached.
