In square foot gardens, the plants grows close together in intensively planted units. The ideal unit is a 4 foot by 4 foot square containing 16 1'x1' plots. Other options are possible, however. The basic 4'x4' plot can be expanded into a 4'x8' square, or even a 10' x 10' to suit your needs, and the space you have available.
